Often the old Dezyfans host repeat performances and have great fun watching their friends' reactions to some of Dezy's classics like the Stress Management song.

The 'house concerts' concept works because it consists of likeminded people who come along expecting great entertainment - their friends have told them so. Normally the guests make a voluntary contribution to Dezy so hosting him needn't cost the host anything.

No two shows are the same. Dezy is constantly expanding his shows - he never stops thinking so all is in a state of motion. His shows often are determined by the venue and the audience. When performing in a black box type theatre he may begin with his "Kilminchy to Carnegie" one man musical (±40 mins) then follow with a less formal interactive show featuring his other music in a more comedy style.
