

Hosting a House Concert for Dezy

Dezy gets under the skin of life and it is funny. No two shows are the same - he is constantly creating. Whether it is a party, corporate, a black box theatre or just a few friends getting together to hear Dezy perform his songs - uproariously funny, uplifting, inspiring, interactive - it's a most memorable evening.

Hosting a House Concert is FUN. You set the date and time and invite your friends and encourage them to bring their friends.

A cabaret style atmosphere works best where every guest has a seat and where Dezy can see each person.

Dezy brings his own **keyboard and equipment** - all he needs is a power outlet.

The simpler the more effective - wine, beer and soft drinks + some light munchies. The entertainment is what it's about.

Number of guests will depend on the size of your home. Ideally you'd like a seat (any kind) for each person.

Dezy's remuneration would come from asking for a **voluntary** suggested contribution of \$20 per person / \$30 for a couple, and the selling of cds.

The format of the show is either one ± 70 minute session or 2 x ± 40 min sessions with a 15-20min break in between. Lots of socializing can be done afterwards. Generally the show starts about 30 minutes after advertised time to allow for people to get a drink, have a bite, and latecomers.

Invitations: Once the date & time is determined, you send out the invitations. [I can help you with this and will gladly design one for you when you've nailed down the details.] I usually send out the invite 3wks in advance, and do some follow ups by email/phone before the event. Hopefully they RSVP. Unfortunately you never really know who will turn up or who will be a no-show but that's not your responsibility.

We trust implicitly that those who are meant to be there will be there.

Don't worry if you think too many will come - somehow one manages perfectly.

Some people may feel the show is not suitable for their children.

Let go of the outcome, sit back, relax and enjoy the show.
